EIGHT DAYS A WEEK RESIDENCY PROJECT AT THE BLUECOAT 2008

Eight Days A Week is currently taking out a 3 month lease on the 'Artist in Residence Space at the Bluecoat', Liverpool to function as an activity and resource space for artists. This has provided a base for a range of creative activities where artists from Liverpool and Cologne can continue the unique cultural exchange programme to develop links with educational and cultural institutions in the city.

Artists' selected to work in the Project Space and the City have included a Basement Project with Liverpool artists collaborating with German and Polish artists, Ulrike Oeter who created the Strassenmuseum [street museum] to engage with particular Jewish histories of Liverpool and the Kölner Graphikwerkstatt Cologne who worked in the Bluecoat's Print Studio.

Since October, Eight Days A Week, the ongoing artists exchange programme between Liverpool and its German twin city of Cologne has set up a project space at the Bluecoat. Some of the artists involved and Jürgen Kisters, Cologne critic and writer, discuss the programme and the future of this 10year programme.
