



Sarah wins 'best student' prize

Sarah Solan, 21, from Spennymoor, has won a national prize for being the best student on her degree course at University.

A former pupil of St John's RC Comprehensive School, Sarah is now a student at the University of Central Lancashire in Preston. She won the Society for General Microbiology (SGM) prize for being the best second year student on a microbiology degree.
