Sign of the times

Preston can now welcome its visitors with a series of new road signs proudly declaring its city status, with help from the University of Central Lancashire.

The University is celebrating its association with Preston by sponsoring a number of signs, all based at strategic points of entry into the city. The top section of the sign will say "Welcome to the City of Preston" with the bottom third carrying the message "Home of the University of Central Lancashire".
